

SCHOOL UNIFORM

VERNEY COLLEGE – SCHOOL UNIFORM

The following is a guide for the correct school uniform that is to be worn by EVERY student of Verney College.

BOYS

- Blue Verney college golf shirt; Grey pants.
- School Blazer compulsory from Grade 4 – 12.
- Navy blue Verney Pullover may be worn.
- Any extra winter jerseys worn must not be visible and should be worn UNDER the school jersey.
- Hoodies are not allowed.
- T-shirts or vests worn under the Verney golf shirt should not be visible and must be white.
- Smooth, black, lace up leather shoes to be worn. Takkies are NOT allowed worn with the full school uniform.
- Boys are to wear navy socks or grey socks.
- Must be clean shaven at all times.
- Hair is to be neat and tidy at all times. Short back and sides. Steps, Mohawks, unnatural spikes etc are NOT allowed.
- Hair may not touch the collar, ears, or the eyebrows if pulled down.
- Highlights in hair are NOT allowed. Neither are unnatural hair colours.
- If boys have braids, the braids must follow the shape of the head, and the ends may not touch the collar.
- Afros may not be higher than 2 cm from the head.
- Boys may not wear any jewellery in the form of rings, arm bands, necklaces or earrings.
- If religious items must be worn then a letter must be supplied by a religious leader.
- If for whatever reason there is a problem regarding the correct uniform being worn, a letter must be written by a parent/guardian indicating the problem and a date by which the issue will be rectified. This letter is then to be signed by a head of grade or the uniform controller.
- Sports and PT – only the school's Track suit and white takkies.

GIRLS

- Blue Verney college golf shirt; grey pants or skirts.
- Navy blue Verney Pullover and Blazer.
- Grey skirts may be worn. It must however be a decent length and should not be shorter than a four finger spacing from above the knee.
- School Blazer compulsory from Grade 4 – 12.
- Any extra winter jerseys worn must not be visible and should be worn UNDER the school jersey.
- Hoodies are not allowed.
- T-shirts or vests worn under the Verney golf shirt should not be visible and must be white.
- Smooth, black, lace up leather shoes, or black, leather baby doll shoes to be worn. Takkies are NOT allowed worn with the full school uniform.

- Stockings may be worn, but must be flesh or navy blue coloured.
- If stockings are worn NO socks are to be worn.
- Girls are to wear short white, grey or navy socks.
- Hair is to be neat and tidy at all times. Hair MUST be tied up, out of and away from the face.
- Only white, black or navy hair bands and clips may be used to tie up hair.
- Hair that is collar length and longer must be tied up.
- Unnatural hair colours are NOT allowed.
- Braids must follow the shape of the head.
- Afros may not be higher than 5 cm from the head.
- Make-up is not allowed.
- Nails must be short and nail polish/false tips are not allowed.
- Earrings may be worn. However, only gold or silver studs may be worn, the size of which should not exceed 5mm. Gold or silver sleepers may be worn. However, the bands must be thin and the diameter should not exceed 1 cm.
- Only ONE earring per ear in the lowest piercing is allowed.
- Coloured contact lenses are not allowed.
- Girls may not wear any jewellery in the form of rings, arm bands, necklaces or earrings.
- If religious items must be worn then a letter must be supplied by a religious leader.
- If for whatever reason there is a problem regarding the correct uniform being worn, a letter must be written by a parent/guardian indicating the problem and a date by which the issue will be rectified. This letter is then to be signed by a head of grade or the uniform controller.
- Sports and PT – only the school's Track suit and white takkies.
